In March this year, long term Tollesbury resident Lisa Goddard took over The Loft vintage tea room, housed in the unique Sail Lofts on Tollesbury waterfront.



Lisa is a superb cook and baker and she is building on a winning formula by adding her own special touches to the menu. She has also extended the opening hours from 10.30 to 4pm, Tuesday to Saturday.

To add to the charm of the tea room, The Loft showcases artwork by local artists and most of the paintings, ceramics, cards and illustrations are for sale. The sail loft architecture; the eclectic mix of vintage furniture; together with the interesting artworks, make this a very unique tea room.

The menu has plenty of choice



and everything is made fresh to order. You can choose from a panini, sandwich, bowl of salad or a lunchtime platter. There are also daily specials and an inspired Kids Lunch Time Platter at £4.75.

The tea choice is extensive from a Good Ol' Mug of Tea through to Egyptian Mint and a Glamour fruit tea. The fresh coffee is hand ground on the premises and there is plenty of choice in the soft

drinks section too. Of course, a tea room is not a tea room without its cakes. Lisa does all the baking for The Loft and offers a yummy choice, which could include coffee and walnut cake, zesty lemon bars, triple choc brownies and granola flapjacks. There is always a dairy and gluten free option. A full afternoon tea is served for £14 or a traditional cream tea is available at £5.10.

There are great waterside walks and bike rides in Tollesbury and The Loft is the perfect place to treat yourself to a scrumptious cake after your exercise.

Please note that there is no disabled access at The Loft as it is in a listed building, but in fine weather there is a small outside seating area.
